Who is Who?

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How many levels are there in an academic year and how long does each level last?

There are four levels in an academic year:

- ▶ A1
- ▶ A2
- ▶ B1
- ▶ B2

In fall and spring semesters, each level lasts about 10 weeks.

In summer semester, courses last about 5/6 weeks.

How many hours are taught weekly in each level?

- ▶ All levels: 25 class hours per week.
 - ▶ A1: Reading (5), Writing (5), Project Presentation (2), Listening & Speaking (11), SOLE (2)
 - ▶ A2: Reading (6), Writing (5), Project Presentation (2), Listening & Speaking (10), SOLE (2)
 - ▶ B1: Reading (8), Writing (6), Listening & Speaking + Project Presentation (9), SOLE (2)
 - ▶ B2: Reading (6), Writing (6), Project Presentation (3), Listening & Speaking (10)

How many B2 exams do we have in an academic year?

- ▶ Students need to pass B2 Exam to go to their faculties.
- ▶ B2 Exam is administered **four times** in an academic year; **August, January, and June** and **after summer school**.
- ▶ **Summer School:** Summer school students can take B2 Exam at the end of the summer school if they do not fail due to absenteeism.

Who can take the January B2 Exam?

- ▶ **January B2 Exam** can be taken by B2 students.
- ▶ **B1 level students** who get **%80 and above** from B1 midterm exam can take the B2 exam.
- ▶ However, students who fail due to absenteeism cannot take the B2 Exam in January.

Who can take the June B2 Exam?

- ▶ **June B2 Exam** can be taken by B1 students who finish B1 level successfully and B2 students.
- ▶ However, students who fail due to absenteeism cannot take the B2 Exam in June.
- ▶ A1 & A2 students cannot take June B2 Exam.

Who can take the August B2 Exam?

- ▶ August B2 Exam can be taken by all students (A1, A2, B1, B2) who study at SOFL without considering their level of English.

Summer School

▶ Who will study at Summer School?

- Students who pass A2 level in Module 3
- Students who fail at B1 level in Module 3
- A1 & A2 students will not be able to attend Summer School.

▶ Summer School lasts around 5/6 weeks. Summer School students can take the B2 Exam even if they fail from the final exam.

▶ There will be B2 Exam at the end of the Summer School. However, summer school students who fail due to absenteeism cannot take the B2 Exam.

B2 Online Summer Course

- ▶ B2 Online Summer Course will prepare students for the B2 Exam.
- ▶ **Who will take the online B2 Course?**
 - B1 students who pass B1 final exam in module 3 but fail in B2 Exam
 - B2 students who fail in B2 Exam in module 3
- ▶ B2 online summer course lasts around 5/6 weeks. It will be a few days a week. Sts will be given work to do at home which will help them pass the B2 Exam.
- ▶ Students who fail from B2 online summer course due to absenteeism cannot take the B2 Exam at the end of B2 summer course.

Project 5%	Details will be given by class teachers
Homework & Participation 5%	See the criteria



HOMEWORK & PARTICIPATION CRITERIA

Grade	Homework & Participation
100-90	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Always prepared for lessons and comes to class on time• Good attitude, volunteers regularly to speak in the target language• Always does his /her homework• Behavior helps class progress• Attends almost all the classes
80-70	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Almost always prepared for lessons and comes to class on time• Good attitude, tries in class, attempts to speak in the target language• Almost always does his /her homework• Behavior almost always helps class progress• Attends most of the classes
60-50	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Sometimes prepared for lessons and comes to class on time• Sometimes tries to speak in the target language in class when called on• Sometimes does his /her homework• Behavior sometimes helps class progress• Attends some of the classes
40-30	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Usually unprepared for lessons and often late for classes• Almost never speaks in the target language• Almost never does his /her homework• Behavior causes problems• Attends classes rarely

20-10	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Always unprepared for lessons and consistently late for classes• Never speaks in the target language• Never does his /her homework• Behavior causes many problems
