ERASMUS MOBILITY PROGRAM

Application Criteria;

- 1. You must be a registered student at ABU at the time of logging an application.
- 2. Vocational School & Undergraduate students must have a minimum of 2.20 CGPA and have completed 1 regular semester before application. **Erasmus + Mobility Program is especially offered for 2nd or 3rd year students.**
- 3. Students must pay the full fee to ABU and *not to the Host Institute*.
- 4. Students are required to apply online from the ABU website and leave the application form with the copy of national ID Card and to Erasmus Office after printed with the approved transcript by student affairs.
- 5. The weighted score for selection will be comprised of: 50% from English proficiency + 50% from CGPA.
- 6. Participants who has special conditions will be given priority;

Disable students will take + 10 points (You can get more information) https://ec.europa.eu/programmes/erasmus-plus/opportunities/individuals/physical-mental-conditions_en Martyr / veteran children or spouse will take + 15 points. Please contact Erasmus Office to get more information.

7. Students who are double major will fill in the application form by selecting a department. The responsibility of the student is to give information to each of the two departments. Erasmus cannot be done from the minor field.

ERASMUS+ KA103 Erasmus European Mobility Program

What is Erasmus+ KA103 European Mobility Program?

Erasmus+ European Mobility is a program that enables student and staff mobility between higher education institutions (HEIs) of 28 EU member countries plus Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway, the FYR of Macedonia, and Turkey. To participate in this program HEIs of these countries apply to European Commission to be able to get eligible for Erasmus Charter for Higher Education (ECHE). International cooperation between HEIs in these countries is established through bilateral student and staff mobility agreement.

ERASMUS+ KA107 International Credit Mobility Program (ICM Program)

What is International Credit Mobility (ICM Program)?

For over 25 years, Europe has funded the Erasmus program, which has enabled over 3 million European students to spend part of their studies in another higher education institution (HEI) elsewhere in Europe. Erasmus+ now opens up these opportunities to students and staff from other parts of the world.

Under international credit mobility, a HEI in a Partner Country can send its students, doctoral candidates or staff to a partner HEI in a Program Country, and vice versa. Similarly, staff can spend a teaching and/or training period abroad for up to 2 months according to the received grant for project.

Erasmus+ KA107 or International Credit Mobility (ICM) programme is a fully-funded mobility program that enables exchange of students, teaching and non-teaching staff between Antalya Bilim University and its partners (Higher Education Institutions-HEI or non-HEIs). The mobilities within the scope of project numbered "2019-1-TR01-KA107-073730" must be completed between the dates of 01/08/2019 and 31/07/2021. Erasmus+ International Credit Mobility Program enables exchange of students from Antalya Bilim University for study mobility activity in the fields of "Civil Engineering", "Mechanical Engineering", for University of Bihac (Bosnia Herzegovina) and in the field of "Computer Engineering" and "Business Management" for Kolegji Universum (Kosovo). This call opens for applications only for the departments specified in this announcement. The budget allocations for the outgoing student mobilities for studies are summarized in the below table.

The students will receive a travel support, which is calculated based on the distance between participants' place of residence and place of activity. See Distance Calculator for further information (http://ec.europa.eu/programmes/erasmusplus/tools/distance_en.htm)

Travel grant will be paid before mobility.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- 1) All participants should abide by the allocated budget constrains since no extra funding is available. (KA103-KA107)
- 2) The travel budget is calculated according to the travel calculator and even if the ticket fare exceeds the travel support amount, no extra funding can be granted to the participants. (KA107)
- 3) Students who benefited from Erasmus+ study and/or internship programs or other mobility programs offered by the university will receive 10pts penalty in their ICM placement points for each time they took part in a mobility program. For one mobility program 10pts, for two mobility programs 20pts, for three mobility programs 30pts penalty will be applied. (KA103- KA107)
- 4. The application form should be printed, signed and handed to MCBU International Office with other required documents (Copy of National Identity Card, Transcript and English Proficiency Document if you have).
- 5. If the student wants to extend the Erasmus mobility to the second semester, he / she has to study the second semester at the same university.
- 6. Participants are able to participate in Erasmus+ Mobility for Students Mobility program without receiving a grant. However, it should be noted that they still have to go through the same application & selection procedures and also submit the required documents (before-during-after mobility) to Erasmus Office of Antalya Bilim University even though they will not receive the funding.
- 7. Organizing the Erasmus exam and announcement of the results must be transparent. For this reason, the applicant's name, surname, school number, department, English exam score, CGPA and final result must be published on the website and sent by e-mail.

- 2. Transcript of Records.
- 3. Copy of National ID Card

 the copy of National ID Card.
- 10 Points to be reduced; Students who previously benefited from the Erasmus + Mobility at the same level of education, Students who entitled to be an Erasmus student in the period of previous exam term within the same level of education but renounce an Erasmus right without a compelling excuse Students who are entitled to practice Erasmus + Mobility renounce their rights for any reason, if they do not submit their petition until the release date announced by Erasmus Office

FINANCIAL SUPPORT:

The European Commission may offer financial support to selected students. The amount of the monthly grant is determined each year by the National Agency and announced in the Application Guide.

• Students are required to sign "Erasmus Grant Agreement" to receive their Erasmus grant.

- The students who benefit from the EU grant will provide the office with their Euro bank account (Deniz bank) details with an official document and following this, a Grant Agreement is formed and signed by both ABU and the student.
- Upon the completion of signatures, 80% of the total grant is transferred to the student's account. 20% is paid after the student fulfill all the requirements, if not, remaining amount will not be transferred. Payments will be made in Euros.
- Paid financial support in not meant to be reimburse, it is for financial assistance for mobility.
- The real amount is calculated according to documents that students submit to Erasmus Office at the end of their program.
