  - ▶ B2: Reading (6), Writing (6), Project Presentation (3), Listening & Speaking (10)

# How many B2 exams are there in an academic year?

- ▶ Students need to pass the B2 Exam to go to their faculties.
- ▶ B2 Exam is administered **four times** in an academic year; **September, January and June** and **after summer school**.
- ▶ **Summer School:** Summer school students can take the B2 Exam at the end of the summer school if they do not fail due to absenteeism.

# Who can take the January B2 Exam?

- ▶ **B1 level students who finish B1 level successfully and B2 students.**
- ▶ **However, students who fail due to absenteeism in Module 2 cannot take the B2 Exam in January.**



# Who can take the June B2 Exam?

- ▶ **B1 students who finish B1 level successfully and B2 students.**
- ▶ **However, students who fail due to absenteeism in Module 4 cannot take the B2 Exam in June.**
- ▶ **A1 and A2 students cannot take the B2 Exam in June.**

# Summer School

- ▶ **Who will study at Summer School?**
  - Summer school is for **B1 and B2 students**.
  - A2 students can study at summer school if there are enough number of students.
  - A1 will not be able to attend summer school.
- ▶ Summer School lasts around 5/6 weeks.
- ▶ B1 students who finish B1 level successfully can take the B2 Exam at the end of the summer school.
- ▶ There will be B2 Exam at the end of the Summer School. However, summer school students who fail due to absenteeism cannot take the B2 Exam.

# Who can take the August B2 Exam?

- ▶ All students (A1, A2, B1, B2) who study at SOFL without considering their level of English.

<b>100-90</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Always prepared for lessons and comes to class on time</li><li>• Good attitude, volunteers regularly to speak in the target language</li><li>• Always does his /her homework</li><li>• Behavior helps class progress</li><li>• Attends almost all the classes</li></ul>
<b>80-70</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Almost always prepared for lessons and comes to class on time</li><li>• Good attitude, tries in class, attempts to speak in the target language</li><li>• Almost always does his /her homework</li><li>• Behavior almost always helps class progress</li><li>• Attends most of the classes</li></ul>
<b>60-50</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Sometimes prepared for lessons and comes to class on time</li><li>• Sometimes tries to speak in the target language in class when called on</li><li>• Sometimes does his /her homework</li><li>• Behavior sometimes helps class progress</li><li>• Attends some of the classes</li></ul>
<b>40-30</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Usually unprepared for lessons and often late for classes</li><li>• Almost never speaks in the target language</li><li>• Almost never does his /her homework</li><li>• Behavior causes problems</li><li>• Attends classes rarely</li></ul>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>•</li></ul>
<b>20-10</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Always unprepared for lessons and consistently late for classes</li><li>• Never speaks in the target language</li><li>• Never does his /her homework</li><li>• Behavior causes many problems</li></ul>
