2. To understand short texts, short letters, written by colleagues, friends, partners, to find important information in texts, be able to understand the main ideas of the text (narration, report, instruction) based on the topics of everyday life.
3. To initiate a conversation and get the necessary information in a shop, post-office, tour-agency office, in a bank, to do order in a restaurant, be able to react to greetings, invitations, apologies, be able to answer simple questions and routine phrases, be able to tell about preferences, dislikes.
4. To write personal letters, simple compositions and essays in the context of the topics.
