SPANISH COURSE DESCRIPTION

The course is designed for students interested in learning Spanish as a foreign language. Students develop their written, oral and comprehensive capabilities. They attend the course of three hours, two times on week.

The Spanish Language Course consists of basic of grammar, pronunciation, speaking, listening, reading and writing. The lessons contain an introduction to the Spanish language, knowledge of Hispanic culture (Spain and Latin America). It covers written and practical grammar through exercises, games and activities in lesson. Students learn vocabulary, expanding concepts and words which must know for each level.

COURSE OBJECTIVES A1 (1) SPA 201

The **A1** This level is learned in two semesters specifically SPA 201 A1 (1) and SPA 202 A1 (2).

A1 objectives:

- Can understand and participate in a simple conversation if a person speaks slowly and reply to the questions concerning oneself, home and work place, numbers, prices.
- Can understand familiar names and words and very simple sentences, for example on notices, posters and catalogs.
- Can write short, simple postcard, for example sending holiday greetings. Can fill in forms with personal information such as name, nationality and address on the registration form a language school or a hotel.
